### **About Grow Transform Belong**

Grow, Transform, Belong (GTB) specialise in delivering services associated with cultural change in correctional settings. With over 20 years' experience of working within the Criminal Justice System in the UK, Dr Lewis has utilised her doctoral knowledge of relationships and culture, to assess and support the transformation of correctional environments in a unique way. Dr Lewis's approach is informed by her pioneering research in Norwegian prisons and her subsequent work establishing the Growth Project, a research-informed Project that has been found to reduce social harm (e.g., assaults, self-harm and conflict) and promote social good (e.g., compliance, growth, retention and engagement) in corrections.

Growth, as a concept, focuses on moving an organisation and its people forward, by focusing on the organisational identity, relationships and change process. It is a mechanism that achieves a rehabilitative culture and is defined as a process rather than a set of outcomes.


