

JUSTICE 2.0- Open Participation & Independence Statement

1. What Justice 2.0 is

Justice 2.0 is a collective campaign initiated by Grow Transform Belong CIC to support fresh thinking and practical change in how the criminal justice system operates — moving towards approaches rooted in human flourishing, accountability, compassion, and community.

Justice 2.0 is about upgrading justice, not owning it.

2. Open, collective participation

Justice 2.0 is intentionally **open**.

Individuals, communities, and organisations are encouraged to engage with the ideas, language, and energy of the campaign in ways that make sense in their own contexts. This may include, but is not limited to:

- Using the informal hashtag **#Justice2Point0**
- Creating content, conversations, events, or initiatives inspired by Justice 2.0
- Exploring reform, rehabilitation, prevention, and justice innovation

This openness reflects our belief that meaningful systems change grows through shared ownership, not central control.

3. Independence and responsibility

While Justice 2.0 was launched by Grow Transform Belong CIC, we do not control, manage, direct, approve, or police how others participate in or interpret the campaign.

Any individual or organisation engaging with Justice 2.0 does so independently and remains solely responsible for their own:

- Actions and activities
- Statements and opinions
- Events, materials, or content
- Compliance with applicable UK laws and regulations

Participation in Justice 2.0 does **not** create any partnership, agency, employment, or representative relationship with Grow Transform Belong CIC unless this has been explicitly agreed in writing.

4. Representation and affiliation

Only initiatives, partners, or programmes explicitly named on our website or official materials are formally affiliated with or authorised to represent Justice 2.0 or Grow Transform Belong CIC.

Views expressed by others using the Justice 2.0 name or hashtag do not necessarily reflect the views of Grow Transform Belong CIC.

5. Our role

Our role is to:

- Contribute ideas, learning, and leadership
- Model values-led practice
- Support constructive dialogue and innovation
- Remain accountable for our own work within Justice 2.0

We welcome a diversity of approaches, while recognising that an open collective will not always move in a single direction.
